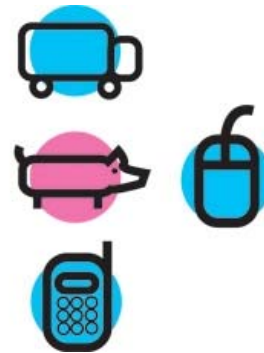


# Electronic recording of pig movements

**eAML2**

Electronic Movement Licensing





- **What is it?**

The eAML2 is the electronic version of the pig movement licence (AML2) and will replace the current paper form in April 2012.

It combines the AML2 and Food Chain Information (FCI) form in one and enables you to complete your pig movements online

- **What are the benefits?**

Pig movements onto Govt database within 24 – 72 hours not 3 weeks – better control in the event of disease outbreak

Real time industry herd register for all 'active' and 'inactive' registered units in England and Wales

- **Do I need a computer?**

No. The service is designed for producers with and without a computer. Producers who have access to a computer & internet can set movements up themselves.

Producers who have no computer with internet access can get their electronic AML2/FCI set up through the eAML2 Bureau Service.



# Timelines

## **October 2011**

- National roll-out of eAML2 and start of 6 months transitional period
- Revised PRIMO (Pigs records, Identification & movement order)
- Start of bureau service operated by MLC SL
- All paper AML2 forms processed by MLC SL

## **April 2012**

- Pig movements can only be reported via the eAML2 system



# Overview of the process

1. Keeper or eAML2 bureau enters intended pig movement on to eAML2 system online/phone/fax/post in advance of movement taking place



2. Keeper prints off haulier summary to give to haulier



3. Pigs loaded and depart farm; keeper to confirm number of pigs loaded and vehicle registration by text message/online/via Bureau Service on day of movement



4. Destination site or abattoir to confirm number of pigs received, DOA etc on eAML2 online account or to Bureau Service within 3 days of arrival



Movements are automatically uploaded to government movement database within 3 days instead of up to 3 weeks

# I don't have a computer

## **Keeper**

- to contact eAML2 Bureau Service by phone/fax/post to get movement set up
- eAML2 Bureau to return appropriate number of Haulier Summaries (and FCI if applicable) by fax/post
  - 1x for haulier to keep for records
  - 1x for receiving site to keep for records (if without IT)
  - 1x for himself to keep for records (if not self-hauling)
- To load pigs
- To confirm movement (actual no of pigs loaded/vehicle registration) by text or via the Bureau Service on same day of movement

## **Receiving abattoir**

- With computer: receives movement & FCI electronically through Bureau Service
- Without computer: FSA OV/inspector confirms abattoir feedback electronically on behalf of abattoir within 3 days

## **Receiving farm**

- With computer: confirms receipt online
- Without computer: confirms receipt via Bureau Service or text message within 3 days



# My abattoir has no computer

## Keeper

- to set up movement on [www.eaml2.org.uk](http://www.eaml2.org.uk)
- to take 2x copies of Haulier Summaries and 1x copy of FCI (if applicable)
  - 1x for haulier to keep for records
  - 1x for abattoir to keep for records
- eAML2 website will automatically prompt for this
- to confirm movement by text or online on day of loading

FSA OV/inspector confirms abattoir feedback electronically on behalf of abattoir within 3 days of arrival

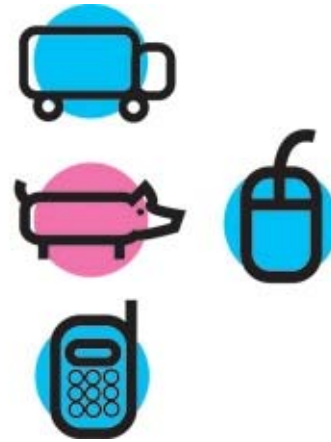
Carcase reports automatically emailed to keeper
