# Reference Laboratory

- Provide a single independent source for testing semen quality
- Samples provided by studs
- 3 Month trial to establish baseline
- 2 year contract to monitor The Standard
- Available for ad hoc testing
- Available for “dispute settlement”
- BPEX to cover lab costs under standard
- Currently subject to tender

# Standards and Audit

- Standards agreed
- Audit guidance being finalised
- Recommend farm type audit process – 4 vet declarations plus one independent inspection a year
- Pilot audit process over next 3 months
- Roll out at Pig Fair in May

# Recording

- Set up a monitoring network to record breeding performance
- Agrosoft users of purchased AI initially
- Approximately 60 across E&W and production type spread
- Encourage direct feedback to breeding companies
